5th Joint Steering Committee Meeting

of the HERAS Project (Submarine Archaeological Heritage on the Western Black Sea Shelf)

The 5th Joint Steering Committee Meeting of the project "Submarine Archaeological Heritage on the Western Black Sea Shelf - HERAS", financed under Romania - Bulgaria Cross-Border Cooperation Programme was held on 28.01.2015 at Golden Tulip Hotel, Varna Bulgaria and it was organized by Partner 3 (Institute of Oceanology - Bulgarian Academy of Sciences).

Representatives of four partners of the HERAS Project attended the meeting (IP GeoEcomar; P2 Constanta Historical Museum, P3 IO-BAS, P4 Kavarna Museum), as Partner 5 - Respiro, (Mr. Mircea Popa) attended the second sea cruise performed by LP with RV Mare Nigrum in that period.

In the opening of the meeting, Dr. Margarita Stancheva, P3 - IO-BAS, who acted as chair of the meeting, presented the agenda of the day. Within the 5th Joint Steering Committee Ms. Jenica Bujini (Technical Coordinator, LP, Constanta) presented the final stage of HERAS project implementation by each activity and by each partner. Public tender situation and completion by each partner was presented. Coordination and management issues (administrative and technical, financial themes), reimbursement claims, approval of Addendum 4 were also considered in details.

Final development stage of GIS activities/maps and project data base were presented by LP and P3 and partners agreed on final data and project results to be included.

Project visibility (web page progress development; awareness raising / dissemination) were discussed with emphasizing on publishing HERAS Project Book, bilingual brochure and photo album.
